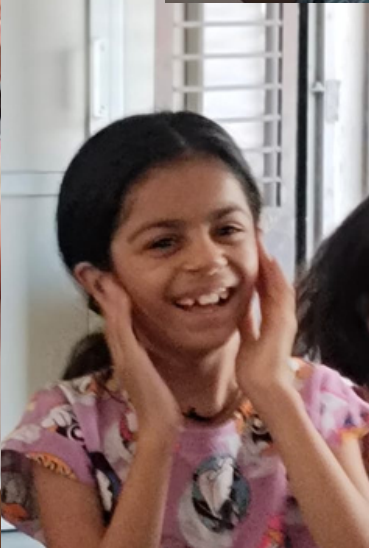

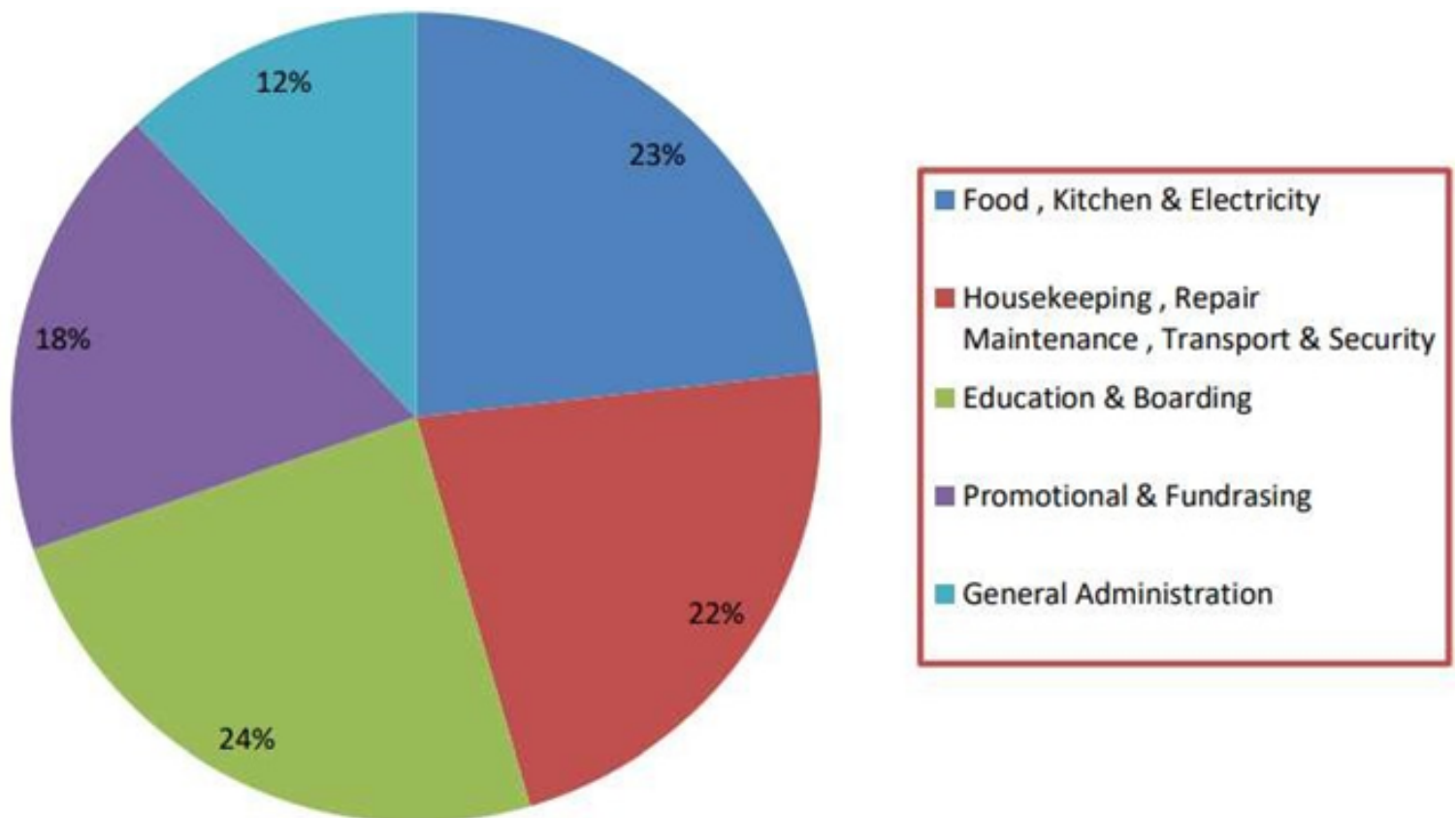

Since our founding in 2002, VKF has remained dedicated to creating opportunities for children from economically disadvantaged families across Gujarat by providing access to quality education and a supportive learning environment.

Our achievements would not have been possible without the dedication of our team, the kindness of our donors, and the strong partnerships we share with respected educational institutions. Together, we have built a nurturing ecosystem that encourages academic success, personal development, and a strong sense of social responsibility among our students.

As we move forward, we remain devoted to our mission of changing lives through education. We plan to broaden our reach, strengthen our initiatives, and continue guiding our students toward achieving their dreams and full potential.

Introduction :

Visamo Kids Foundation (VKF) is a prominent non-governmental organization based in Ahmedabad, Gujarat. Established in 2002, VKF emerged in response to the devastating earthquake that struck Gujarat, leaving many families and communities in dire need of support. From its humble beginnings, VKF has grown into a dynamic and sustainable initiative dedicated to providing free education to children from underprivileged families across Gujarat.



VKF's mission is to empower children from impoverished backgrounds by offering them access to quality education and a secure learning environment. The foundation aims to break the cycle of poverty by equipping these children with the knowledge and skills necessary to build a better future for themselves and their communities. VKF envisions a Gujarat where every child, regardless of their socio-economic status, has the opportunity to achieve their full potential.

Comprehensive Overview of VKF's Screening, Admission, and Support Process

VKF and collaboration with grassroots NGOs, conducts a meticulous screening process each year, typically around Navratri, to identify children from economically and socially disadvantaged communities in Gujarat who show potential for academic excellence. Grassroots NGOs play a pivotal role in this process, acting as crucial intermediaries between VKF and the local communities. They facilitate outreach and help in identifying suitable candidates. The screening involves administering pictorial tests to assess the children's potential, which are then evaluated by qualified psychologists. Based on these assessments, children with exceptional academic potential are shortlisted for further consideration.

Shortlisted children are then invited to participate in a ten-day camp held at VKF's shelter in Bopal, Ahmedabad. This camp, which requires parental consent, is designed to provide a comprehensive evaluation through a series of mental and physical tests. During the camp, the residential staff, known as 'Gruhmatas' (house mothers), closely observe the children, assisting them in adjusting to the new environment. Simultaneously, home visits are conducted to verify the backgrounds of the shortlisted candidates. These visits are carried out by field teams from partnering institutions or NGOs, following a standardized format provided by Visamo to ensure unbiased third-party evaluation.

The camp culminates in a final interview process where parents meet with the managing trustee and a panel of selection board members. This interview is crucial in finalizing the selection and confirming admission to Visamo, which is conditional upon the children's acceptance into one of VKF's partner schools. VKF facilitates admissions into prominent schools such as DPS, Anand Niketan, Zydus, and St. Kabir, with the process typically concluding by December or early January. To ease the transition, VKF initiates a Bridge-in Program, preparing children for their time at Visamo and their integration into these schools.



Once admitted, children at Visamo receive additional academic support through supplementary teaching classes provided by part-time teachers. Each child's needs are addressed through Individual Educational Plans (IEPs), and specialized care is given to those with special learning needs. Volunteers contribute significantly by offering one-on-one attention to select children. Beyond academics, VKF organizes various activities aimed at holistic development, including life skills training, counseling, personality grooming, and career guidance. These activities, along with interactions with eminent professionals, help broaden the children's horizons and prepare them for future opportunities.



Throughout their educational journey at Visamo, which begins from Class I and spans twelve years across various educational boards (CBSE, ICSE, GSEB), children are supported by a structured Bridge-out Program designed to prepare them for life after Visamo. This program includes mentoring, aptitude testing, career guidance, and exposure to diverse fields of study and career-building opportunities. For senior students in Classes VIII to XII, VKF provides additional support through career fairs, interactions with field experts, and life skill coaching, ensuring they are well-prepared and confident as they transition out of Visamo and into their future endeavors.

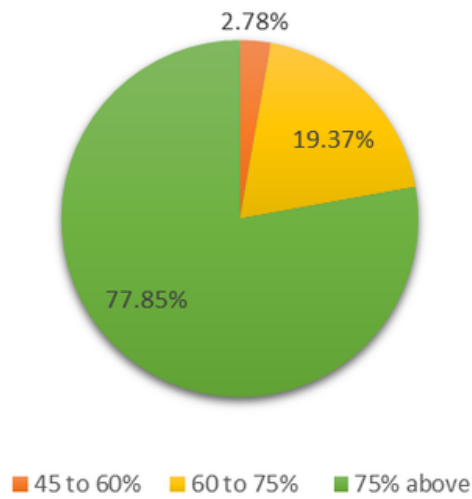

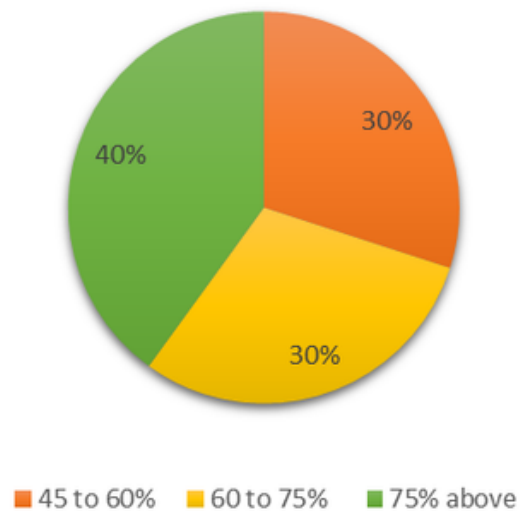

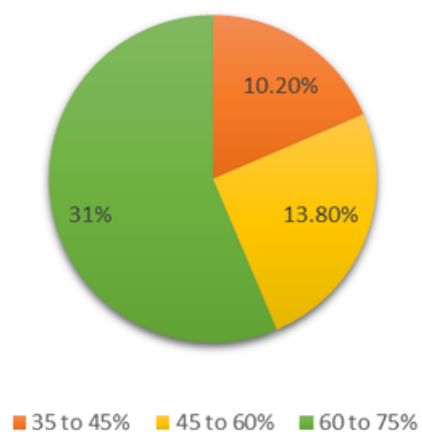

AI Classes :



At Visamo Kids Foundation, we have introduced AI classes for our older children this year, helping them stay aligned with the changing world and equipping them with skills for the future.

French Language Class

This year, Visamo Kids Foundation has also introduced French language classes for students from Std. 6 to 8 as an additional language program. Volunteers from La Forêt Organization are teaching the children French, providing them with an opportunity to learn a new language and broaden their global exposure.



KFTL Visit

As part of a monthly Saturday activity, children visit the Kalorex Future Tech Lab to explore the world of science and technology. These visits help spark their curiosity, develop scientific thinking, and encourage hands-on learning. The experience inspires children to take a greater interest in science, innovation, and future technologies.

Medical camps -2025 to 2026

An Eye Check-up Camp was organized by Visamo Kids Foundation to promote children's eye health and ensure early detection of vision-related issues. The camp provided free eye screening and awareness about the importance of regular eye care.

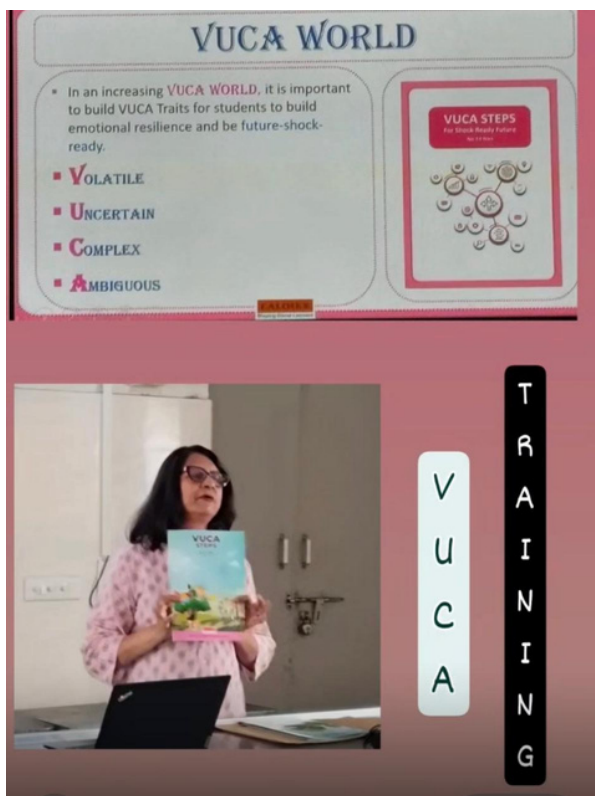


Staff training and Development



DHI Sessions:

DHI Sessions are organized for staff members to support their personal growth, professional development, and self-improvement. VUCA Sessions:

મિત્રોએ પહેલાથી જ પ્રવેશ મેળવી લીધો હતો. હું સતત નાણાકીય દબાણ અને આત્મ-શંકા સામે ઝગમગ રહી હતી. પરંતુ આજે, મને લાગે છે કે મારી મહેનત ખરેખર રંગ લાવી છે." તેણીએ વધુમાં ઉમેર્યું હતું કે, "આ સિદ્ધિ મારી એકલીની નથી, પરંતુ એ તમામ વ્યક્તિની છે, જેમણે મારામાં વિશ્વાસ વ્યક્ત કર્યો. ખાસ કરીને, મારા માર્ગદર્શકો અને વિસામો કિડ્સ ફાઉન્ડેશન, જે ખરેખર એક પરિવારની જેમ મારી સાથે સતત ઉભા રહ્યા અને મને સતત મહેનત સાથે આગળ વધવાની પ્રેરણા આપી હતી." વિસામો કિડ્સ ફાઉન્ડેશન નીલમની શૈક્ષણિક યાત્રા અને તેના વ્યક્તિગત વિકાસને આકાર આપવામાં મુખ્ય ભૂમિકા ભજવી છે. સંસ્થાના માર્ગદર્શન, દેખભાળ અને સતત સમર્થન દ્વારા, નીલમે અવરોધોને સફળતા તરફ દોરી જવાના પગથિયાંમાં પરિવર્તિત કર્યા છે. હવે તે એવા ભવિષ્યની આશા કરે છે, જ્યાં તે બીજાઓની સેવા કરી શકે, તેના પિતાને ટેકો આપી શકે અને તેના જેવા અન્ય બાળકો માટે પ્રેરણા બની શકે.





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
